Background and Program Information

The acceleration to establish ASEAN Community by the year 2015 has shown commitments of ASEAN leaders to strengthen regional cooperation and move towards a more integrated community. However, ASEAN has been facing with disparities among member countries especially those with transitional economies. ASEAN is therefore in dire need of a firm regional architecture that is ASEAN-centered to intensify efforts towards community-building, broaden and deepen ASEAN's external relations and strengthen its role as the primary driving force in the existing regional mechanisms. The potential of next generation is seen essential as a future direction in shaping ASEAN regional architecture on a basis of acquiring empirical and practical knowledge to eventually narrow the development gap in ASEAN countries.

Mekong Friendship Project 2014 is a youth exchange program, which contributes to developing ties and understanding for co-existence among nations in the Mekong sub-region Community. In addition, Mekong Friendship Project will also instill good attitude and social awareness of the regional development issues in order to ensure genuine people-centered, durable peace and prosperity of the region as we move forward to ASEAN Community.

Eligibility of applicants

1. The funding is open for **Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Thailand, and Vietnam citizens**.
2. Applicants must be between **age 18 and 21 years**.
3. Applicants must have basic knowledge about Mekong sub-region Community and ASEAN Community.
4. Applicants must have a good command in English.
